



1 - Organisation

O'Cerdanya is organised by the COC, CCIO and COTE66 clubs.

The organisers attach great importance to the respect of persons, property and nature and may disqualify any participant failing to show such respect.

In case of serious necessity, a day's event or timings may be modified or cancelled.

In case of need (for example the theft of a control), the organisers may make appropriate adjustments to the race time of the affected runners.

The organisers offers in the online registration, a temporary insurance to any participant interested .

The event will be organised in conformity with the legislation in force in the two countries.

A safety service equipped with a vehicle will be present at the event.

2 - The Event

O'Cerdanya is a foot orienteering event.

Its five stages will take place as follows:

11 August, at La Llagonne

12 August, at Sauto

13 August, at Fontanals

14 August, at Fontanals

15 August, at La Molina

A model event will be held on 10 August at Font-Romeu.

The races on the first two days will count towards the O'Pyrène challenge and the French national ranking system. None of the races will count for the Copa Catalana.

The organisers reserve the right to disqualify or penalise a runner for failure to respect the event rules.

Prizes will be awarded to the first runners in each IOF age category on the basis of the total time taken for the five stages.

Start times for each day will be displayed at the event centre and posted on the internet.

Starts will be at one minute interval.

There will be no children's crèche, but parents may request split start times before 15 July. There will be an area available for children- where they can stay under their parents' responsibility.

Runners are responsible for clearing and checking the clearance of their SI card. At the end of each race participants may retain their map but must not aid those yet to start.

Sixteen courses are being planned but further courses may be added.

3 - The runners

O'Cerdanya is open to all, whether or not members of a national orienteering association.

French law requires runners who are not members of the French orienteering federation to present a medical certificate stating that there is no counter-indication to their practising orienteering on a competitive basis. Medical certificates must be sent before 15/7/2017 to the organization via email. In the case of not presenting this document in advance, the runner will not be able to take part on the orienteering event.

The organisers reserve the right to limit the number of participants and to halt entries.

Entries will not be accepted in the absence of the required details and the payment.

Runners take part under their own responsibility.

The event jury reserves the right, after consulting a doctor, to refuse to allow a competitor to start or to pursue his or her race.

No competitor may impersonate another in any race.

Runners must respect the highway code, private property and the natural environment. Any competitor obliged to abandon a race must report this to the organisers.

Participants are required to assist any runner in difficulty (accident, health problem etc.).

4 - Entry Fees

Per day: adult 13 euros, under twenties 9 euros until 15 January,
adult 15 euros, under twenties 10 euros until 15 April
adult 18 euros, under twenties 12 euros after 16 April

Beginners' course: 10 euros at any time; way-marked course: 2 euros at any time.

Entries not finalised by these date limits will be subject to the next higher fee.

Repayments:

Any repayment requested will be subject to a deduction of 50 per cent after 15 June. As from 31 July entry fees will not be reimbursed.

In case of force majeure, At the discretion of the organization, the organisers reserve the right to cancel one or more races without repayment of entry fees.

5 – Image reproduction rights

During the competition, you may be filmed or photographed and the photos or films may be displayed on our site www.ocerdanya.clubcoc.cat.

Participants have the right of access to and correction of their personal details (including image reproduction rights). For this, contact the organisers.

6 - Acceptance of these rules

The participants declare by the fact of their entry their acceptance of these rules.

7.- Versions

This regulation is established in French, Catalan, English and Spanish. In the case it would be any differences in the interpretation, the French version overrules the others versions.
